Conseils d'utilisation

- . Chaque **fiche** correspond à une **semaine**, et chaque **ligne** correspond à un **jour**.
 - . On commence par **lire** à l'enfant les mots au **recto**, puis on lui demande de les **répéter** (lui faire **cacher les noms** avec une règle ou une bande de papier opaque).
 - . On passe ensuite au **verso**, et on lui demande de **montrer** les mots appris qu'on lui nomme (en s'aidant de la formulation proposée à partir de la semaine 15).
 - . Toujours au **verso**, on demande à l'enfant de **nommer** les noms appris qu'on lui montre.
 - . Chaque jour, on **reprend au verso** tous les mots déjà vus les **4 jours précédents**.
 - . Ensuite on fait faire les **exercices** correspondants sur la fiche du jour.
 - . Jusqu'à la semaine 14, on apprend 3 nouveaux mots par jour. A partir de la semaine 15, ce sont essentiellement des **révisions**, peu de nouveaux mots sont à apprendre.
 - . Les **nuages rouges** correspondent à des **explications à donner** :
- 1 : Expliquer au départ qu'il arrive parfois que les voyelles anglaises s'entendent comme les voyelles françaises, mais que c'est malheureusement rarement le cas. Il faut donc toujours **bien connaître** les mots pour les **prononcer correctement**.
